





ABOUT THE PLAY

EMOTIONAL BAGGAGE concerns strangers who cross paths in a train station, each one dealing with their own hang-ups, issues, stress, or situation. A new person enters the station and challenges the strangers to face their fears and let go of their "emotional baggage." Will they be able to let go and move on when their train arrives? The hallmark of this performance is that it contains no spoken dialogue; the actors all perform their characters in silence. There are two versions of this performance: The VHSL cast (filmed earlier in the month) and the so-called "Friends and Family Cast," where we switched out the actors in certain roles, as noted below.
